Our Estate Vineyard


Most of the nine wines that comprise Tuxedo Red were grown in Regan Estate Vineyard. BARGETTO WINERY'S Regan Estate Vineyard is located on a southwest slope in the Santa Cruz Mountains, overlooking the majestic Monterey Bay. This cool climate vineyard allows the grapes to develop rich and complex flavors over an exceptionally long growing season. These distinct and age-worthy wines from Regan Vineyards reflect this unique location. We are committed to sustainable winegrowing practices such as: cover crops, biodiesel, solar electricity and biological pest control.

Winemaker's Notes

The 2014 Tuxedo is a luscious blend of 9 different lots of wine, with heavy influences from two of our favorite wines to blend: Zinfandel and Petite Sirah. The color of this wine is deep garnet. Sweet raspberries, chocolate covered cherries and baking spice make up the initial aromas. As the wine opens up, lightly toasted oak, plum, potpourri and rhubarb pie develop on the nose. Flavors of blackberry jam, dried cranberries and bright acidity blend nicely with soft tannins from the Petite Sirah and Zinfandel. Hints of black pepper, cinnamon and sweet tobacco add interesting layers to the palate and finish. This wine is medium-bodied with lots of layers and soft tannins. The varietals blended together complement one another and add intrigue to the nose, palate and finish of the wine. This Rosso is drinkable now or can last 2-3 years.

Food pairing include: burgers, pizza, or a BBQ tri-tip.
