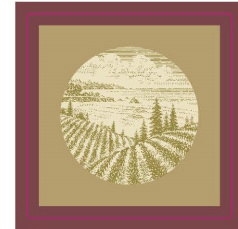
OUR ESTATE VINEYARD

This cool climate vineyard allows the grapes to develop rich and complex flavors over an exceptionally long growing season. These distinct and age-worthy wines from Regan Vineyards reflect this unique location. We are committed to sustainable winegrowing practices such as: cover crops, bio-diesel, solar electricity and biological pest control.

WINE MAKER’S NOTES

This Reserve Merlot has a beautiful deep garnet color and opens with intense and complex aromatics. Notes of blackcurrant, plum, and black cherry fill your nose and entice your palate. A touch of Cabernet Sauvignon from Perucci Vineyards has been blended in to add complexity to the aromatic profile, bringing richness and softness to the palate as well. The tannins on this powerful Merlot are full but soft. The finish is long, carried though by a lasting acidity one expects from our cool-climate Santa Cruz Mountains Merlot. Pairing suggestions include lamb chops, sharp cheeses, lasagna, and dark chocolate.
