Our Estate Vineyard




This cool climate vineyard allows the grapes to develop rich and complex flavors over an exceptionally long growing season. These distinct and age-worthy wines from Regan Vineyards reflect this unique location. We are committed to sustainable winegrowing practices such as: cover crops, biodiesel, solar electricity and biological pest control.

Winemaker's Notes

The 2023 Santa Cruz Mountains Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon opens with aromas of blackberry, currant, and plum. A blend of four Santa Cruz Mountain vineyards, this wine is full of complexity and nuance. Dark fruit flavors are met with sweet oak and notes of tobacco and leather. This Cabernet Sauvignon is full-bodied with firmly structured tannins and a long, full finish. To achieve this texture and mouthfeel, the wine was bottled unfiltered – Don't be alarmed if some natural sediment has formed.

Food pairings include: meatballs with Bolognese, prime rib, aged sharp cheeses and bittersweet chocolate.
